



WHAT IS THE PRESBYTERIAN (USA) CHURCH?

We're a group of Protestants governed by a Representative Democracy.


Did you know the US governing organization is based on the Presbyterian model? It's true!

We elect three types of officers in our church:

- Elders, who make up the Session/the governing body of the church;
- Deacons, whose role is that of sympathy, witness, and service after the example of Jesus Christ, and
- Trustees, who manage financial, legal and property affairs of the church

You can serve, too!

Church officers (elders & deacons) are elected from and by the congregation. To learn more about this process, contact Chris Harrison at harrison@downeycleveland.com.



HOW ARE WE STRUCTURED?

Governing body of congregation Ordained Ministers of the Word and elders, all elected by the congregation

Elders and ministers from congregations who oversee the local churches

Representatives elected from each Presbytery to oversee several presbyteries

The national governing body made up of equal numbers of lay people and clergy chosen by the presbyteries

WHY PRESBYTERIAN?

We are a part of a denomination that is older than America! Before the Revolutionary War, Presbyterians immigrated here, seeking a religious freedom that they didn't find in Europe. In fact, there were so many Presbyterians by the time independence was declared, some in England called the American Revolution the Presbyterian Revolution.

Half the Ivy League colleges were founded by Presbyterians. Dozens of US Presidents were Presbyterians. But what is the benefit of being a part of this denomination today?

Thinking of higher education, your membership in this Presbyterian church will entitle your children to a 50% tuition discount to Presbyterian College in Clinton, SC, and a free ride to Austin College, just outside of Dallas, TX. Locally, we honor our denominations legacy of education by providing one of the best preschool educations in the city (thanks to our outstanding preschool staff!). Members of our church who enroll their children in our preschool receive a tuition discount and the benefit of early enrolment.

Thanks to our denomination, there is a network of high-quality retirement communities, called the Presbyterian Homes, with locations throughout the Southeast. We enjoy camps and conference centers, especially Montreat, in a beautiful valley in North Carolina. Our ministers are educated at outstanding Presbyterian seminaries. And we are a part of a network of churches, providing mutual support and encouragement.

There are multiple benefits to being a member church in the PCUSA. Among the most practical, as a member of FPC, you may use our parking lot to walk down to the Square when it's busy!
