TUESDAY EVENING IMMEDIATE NEEDS:

“Traffic Cop”— meet our guest families at our main lot entrance. Work with other volunteers who regulate intake of families. Needed: someone who can be there from 4:00- 7:00 PM on a regular basis: once a month, twice a month, or every week. (adult)

Spanish Speakers— Tuesday evenings welcome over half of our families speaking Latin Spanish. We can always use someone who can converse with our guests. (high school to adult)

YOUR SCHEDULE:

Pick Up or Deliver Goods— Someone with an SUV or a pick-up truck to help current volunteers pick up diapers, period products, and other items. Flexible schedule. (adults only)

Also, we are looking for someone with a truck or SUV to ride with a partner to deliver food boxes to Marietta City Schools families who live off of Delk Road. Most likely on Wednesdays, possibly Thursdays. (adults only)

Pantry workers on days not Tuesdays— assemble homeless kits and pantry boxes, keeping stock organized. Preparing diapers, baby wipes, and period products for distribution. One or two people each month to meet in the pantry and make sure food is not out-of-date. (any age, under 16 with an adult)

Spanish translators— every week a greeter checks in with each family and reminds them that we have members of FPC who are happy to pray for them and their concerns. Half of the prayer requests are in Spanish. We need someone who can translate cards after Tuesday evening and return them to FPC by Saturday morning. (High school to adult)
