## Called Congregational Meeting: Sunday, January 5, 2025

The Session of FPC has called a congregational meeting for Sunday, January 5, for the purpose of electing Church Officers and Trustees, to be held immediately following both the 8:30am and 11am services. Church Officers serve and are elected by the congregation and Trustees are elected by the corporation and serve as its Directors.

The congregation will vote on a new slate of Church Officers nominated by the Officer Nominating Committee. Nominees and their bios will be published and made available online and in the Gathering Space prior to January 5.

Immediately afterwards and in accordance with the Bylaws of the Congregation, the congregation will reconvene as members of the Corporation, First Presbyterian Church of Marietta, Inc., for the purpose of electing trustees who are nominated by the Session. The Session nominates Beverly Kelly, bio to be included with those above, as a new Trustee for a three-year term and nominates Russell Davis and Ann Stoskopf as Trustees for another three-year term.
