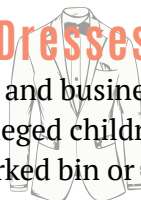

Donate Paperback Books for Cobb County Jail Library

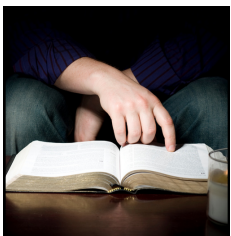

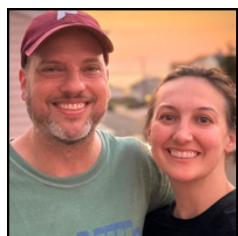
