*Affirmation of Faith The Nicene Creed

We believe in one God, the Father, the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all that is, seen and unseen. Go to fpcmarietta.org/events Meet the homeowners: D is a Project Utility Manager for Cobb County DOT, helping ensure residents have quality infrastructure. Despite steady work and overtime, he and his wife Dreika can't find affordable housing in the county he serves. They rent a small, substandard townhome just outside Cobb, dealing with crowding, water damage, leaky plumbing, and a flooded basement. Raising a blended family, four of their children live at home: 22-year-old DeNecia, 15-year-old DeKeria, 2-year-old D, and 1-year-old Daniel. Though Dreika keeps a tidy home, safety concerns and limited space stifle the family's vibrant energy. Being selected to build a Habitat home felt like winning a prize. For D & Dreika, homeownership means stability, safety, and space for their kids to grow and play.


